The Geriatric Care Manager is usually educated and experienced in any of several fields related to aging life care/ care management, including, but not limited to nursing, gerontology, social work, or psychology, with a specialized focus on issues related to aging and elder care. Geriatric Care Managers address a broad range of issues related to the well-being of older adults.
